This month's guest speakers are:

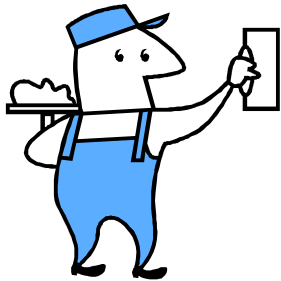
John Barksdale & Christy Draper
